“Paired Reading-Parents and Children Reading Together”

“Mom, can we go to the library?” How often will your child ask this question? Are you raising a child who loves to read? Paired reading is a technique that guides parents in reading with their child and supporting their child's early literacy development. This workshop is designed for parents and their children in *kindergarten thru 3rd grade*. The paired reading technique will be modeled for parents with an opportunity for parents to practice with their child. Give your child the opportunity to love reading by introducing these techniques in his/her early literacy development. This will ensure that your child will have the ability to read and understand text and gain a solid foundation of study skills. Parents may bring their K-3 child with them.
