ACT 57 – Local Tax Collection Law

Townships/Municipalities have from today, the law's effective date, until January 9, 2023, to adopt the resolution or ordinance. Act 57 allows taxpayers who fail to receive a tax notice during their first year of occupancy to apply for a waiver from penalties and additional costs from the tax collector.

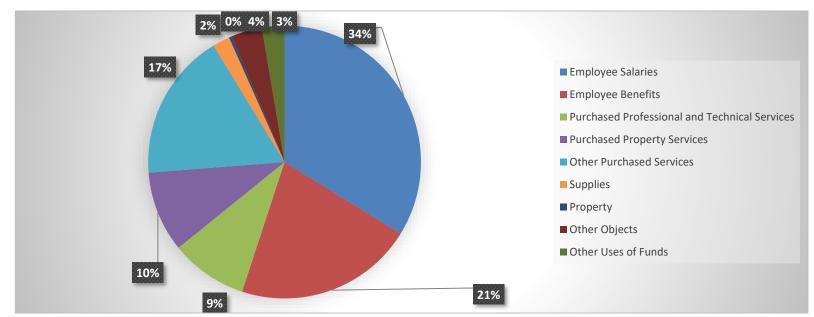
