Credit Recovery is an added safety net for our high school students where programming is designed for students who didn't pass a subject the first time. Academy Park High School's credit recovery courses use a personal touch to teach unlearned concepts, letting students move past material they've already mastered. Offered four times during the 2021-2022 school year, the credit recovery program gives students the flexibility to fit courses in when it best suits their schedule. The program offers courses in English, Math, Social Studies, and Science.

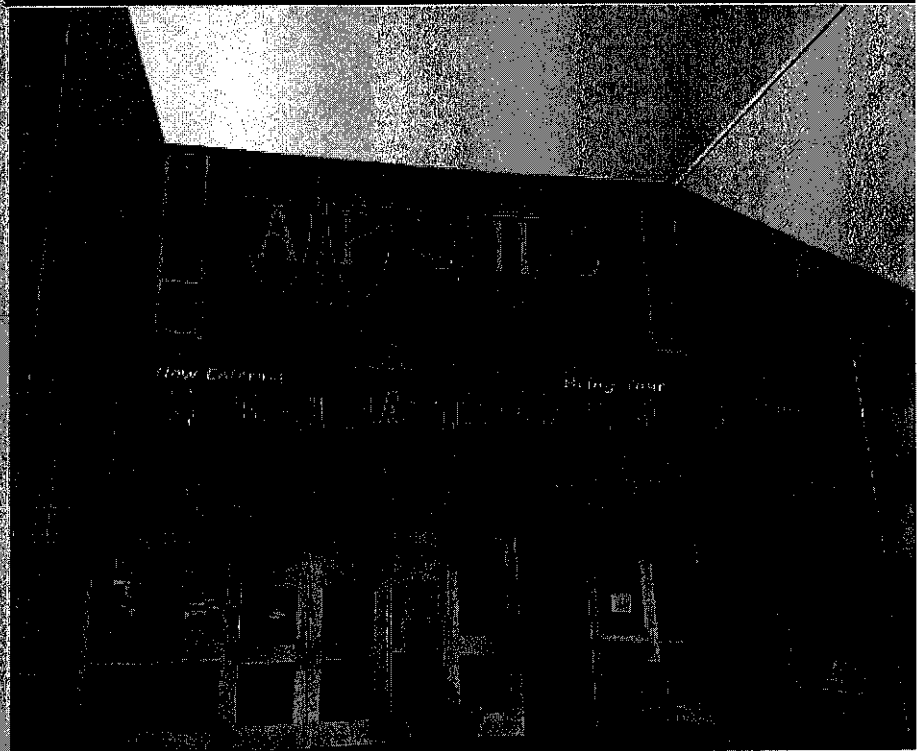
Stay Involved!
