

Math Twister

1. Use Post-it notes to write an answer value. For addition facts we used 4, 5, 6, and 7).
2. Each color on the twister board was the same number. For example, all the red circles will have the number 4 post-it notes.
3. To remember which color is which number you can place a small post-it note on the spinner to label each color.
4. Spin the spinner and call out whichever hand or foot designated (ex: left foot or right hand). Then instead of calling out the color say an addition problem that corresponds to the appropriate answer.
5. For example, if I spun Right hand red, I would say, "Right hand $3+1$ ".
6. This game can also be used for subtraction, multiplication, and division.
